
Why do you cycle in Newburyport? (check all that apply) 246 responses





How frequently do you cycle in Newburyport? 246 responses













Most Important – Downtown

Other Bike/Walk Issues

High Street (35)

- Need for marked bike lanes, new curb cuts, islands
- Repaint / add better visibility to crosswalks

Hale Street (12)

- Designated bike lanes

- Extremely dangerous cyclists and peds
- Need for sidewalk

Merrimack Street (13)

- Need for bike lanes
- Crosswalks with flashing lights @ Kent & Merrimac
