- Bike Share Planning Group Update (Sheila)
 - o Bike share presentation ST Parks Comm 7-18-24.pdf
 - o Bike Share will be for Pedal (only) Bikes
 - o Three Sub-Groups
 - Station Siting (Sheila)
 - Approx 30 bikes, 5-6 stations
 - Station Location Selection by Committee
 - 1) MBTA Station on Rail Trail (Parks Commission Approved)
 - 2) Multi-Use Trail Near Custom House (Waterfront Trust)
 - 3) Rail Trail at Washington St (Parks Commission Approved)
 - 4) Along Sally Snyder Way at Cashman Park (Parks Commission Approved)
 - 5) Waterfront Park Information Center (City Council or Waterfront Trust)
 - Other location suggested by Parks Department
 - o Inn Street Park / Green Street Parking Lot
 - Considering eventually expanding to Plum Island Refuge
 - Gov't Relations (Rick)
 - Trying to connect with Mayor to meet to designate a City staff person to work on this project
 - Goal is to get City Council Approvals by October
 - o to create a budget line item and transfer funds to this
 - acceptance of grants
 - establish revolving fund
 - Rick has talked to Afroz who has expressed support
 - Other Councilors pending outreach

- After CC approval, RFP would be released
- Fundraising (Eric)
 - Goal is to raise approx \$25K annually
 - Estimated approx 10% will be funded by user fees
 - A few grant applications are in the works
 - Also looking for sponsorships locally
- Chamber of Commerce Youth Council have connected with NLS to assist as well and connect with Charitable Foundation
- Report on Daylight Ride on the Refuge (Sheila)
 - Approx 6 NLS people staffed the NLS booth at the refuge
 - Refuge reported that is was a good event
- Bike rodeo planning (Bonnie)
 - Bonnie has connected with our regional coordinator for MassDOT Safe Routes to School (MassBike will run the rodeo)
 - Discussed with Nock/Molin Principals
 - 4th and 5th graders
 - 2-hours after school
 - coordinate with Youth Services
 - also trying to reach out to Police
 - Riverside Cycles repair
 - Potential to recruit 8th graders to assist
 - Goal to hold 3rd week in September
 - Looking to get some organizers
 - Juliet and Kristen volunteered to assist
 - Maybe eventually extend this to adults (with Riverside Cycle support potentially)
- Report on request to increase speed to 30/35 mph on High, Merrimac, Hale, Graf, Parker (Rick)
 - City Council resoundingly shut this down after public outcry
 - Kristen and Eric submitted neighborhood petitions against this
 - Next steps -- request to lower Low Street speed limit, which would require a vote to request rescinding the special speed limit (35 mph) on Low Street
 - City is currently doing a study at the North Atkinson St intersection to submit for SRTS funding
 - City is considering future potential SRTS project along Youth Recreation Center portion of Low St
- Update on T-shirt fundraising campaign (Eric)
 - Fundraising going well -- \$650 raised to date
 - People are donating extra at the check out too!
- Other Business
 - Juliet will reach out to Andrew Levine regarding Safe Streets and Roads for All funding (MVPC can also assist with data)

- o Rick shared MVPC updates
 - Truck exclusion for Turkey Hill Rd
 - Have trail counters to install at 6 locations in Newburyport
